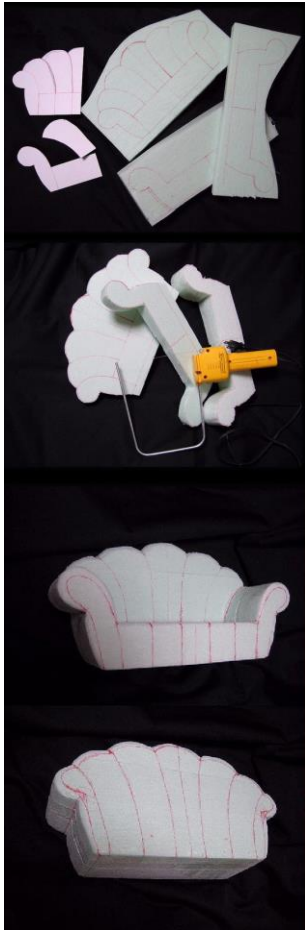

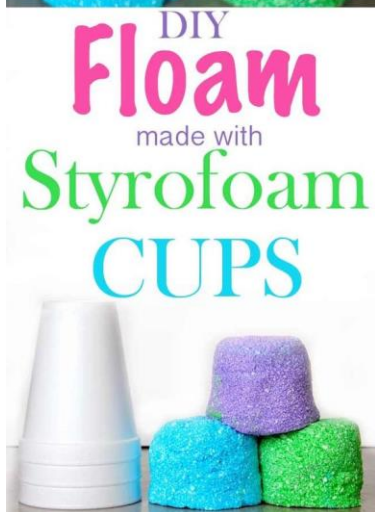
Create this refreshingly colorful and unique **wreath** using cut styrofoam and drink umbrellas.
